

THE ANATOMY OF A MOP HANDLE

HANDLE LENGTH

Typically ranges between 54"-66" in length.

HANDLE MATERIAL

May be wood, aluminum, fiberglass, or vinyl-covered.

HEAD MATERIAL

May be plastic or steel.

HANDLE ATTACHMENT

Where the mop attaches. Can be side-gate Invader® (left), clamp-style Gripper® (right), or Bolt-on.

HANDLE COLORS

Variety of colors available allow users to color-code for reduced cross-contamination, improved organization/tracking, or blending into environments. Most common colors include blue, green, gray, red, and black. Color variation may be in handle or head.



HANDLE CONSTRUCTION



INVADER® WET MOP HANDLE


Thumbwheel clamps the mop firmly in place. Most optimal for 1" headband mops.



GRIPPER® WET MOP HANDLE


Holds mops firmly between the jaws of the mop handle. Most optimal for 5" headband mops.

VINYL-COATED ALUMINUM


- Lightweight and durable
- Vinyl-coating improves durability and grip






ALUMINUM


- Lightweight and durable
- Good for general-purpose cleaning
